

COLLEGE OF FINE AND APPLIED ARTS

There were 407 beginning freshmen enrolled in the College of Fine and Applied Arts in the Fall of 2001: 179 males and 228 females. Of these students, 371 had both HSPR and ACT:C. The persistence rates for the latter group are described in the table below. Each cell represents the number of students in the cell with that particular combination of HSPR and ACT:C. The percentage in that cell represents the percent of students who were enrolled as of the tenth day of Fall 2002.
