<sup>1</sup>Tuition rates for Chicago and Urbana-Champaign reflect rates assessed for 12 or more semester credit hours. Springfield students are assessed tuition based on a per credit hour charge. In AY 2002 the per credit hour rates were \$99.50 for undergraduates and \$112.00 for graduates. AY 2003 rates will increase to \$109.50 and \$123.25, respectively. Springfield tuition rates reflect 30 annual credit hours for undergraduates and 24 for graduates. Mandatory fee rates for all three campuses exclude refundable fees.

<sup>2</sup>Engineering students pay an additional \$400.

<sup>3</sup>The transportation fee is only assessed to full-time students. Full-time Dentistry and Medicine students are not assessed this fee.

<sup>4</sup>Rates include disability insurance for first and second year Medical students of \$70.20 in AY 2002; all other Medical students paid \$87.76. In AY 2003, the rates include a disability insurance rate of \$58 assessed to all students.

<sup>5</sup>Resident Hall rate for double occupancy with a 14 meal plan.

<sup>6</sup>Springfield student enrolled in the Capital Scholars program are assessed an additional \$300 instructional fee.

<sup>7</sup>Rates shown are for students under age 35; students age 35 to 64 are assessed \$436.

<sup>8</sup>Rates listed are for the new Lincoln Residence Hall with a meal plan.

<sup>9</sup>Students in engineering, chemistry and life sciences curricula are assessed an additional \$576. Students in architecture, art, and music are assessed an additional \$200 at the lower division undergraduate level and \$400 at the upper division undergraduate and graduate student levels.

<sup>10</sup>Students enrolled in Law graduate programs pay the same tuition rate as students enrolled in the Juris Doctor program.
