Purpose

The purpose of this study is to report enrollment and characteristics of new transfer students² to the University of Illinois at Chicago for the 2004 fall term. The study provides data for use by community college counselors, faculty members, and administrators in determining the mobility of their students. It also provides data for UIC officers involved in recruitment, admissions, and instructional services.

Summary of Results

1. A total of 1,386 new students enrolled as transfer students fall 2004, up from last year's unusually low number (at 1,245, fall 2003 transfer enrollment was a ten-year low which followed a very large 2002 transfer enrollment of 1,973, the highest since 1994). The relatively small 2003 and 2004 transfer classes aimed to balance the large freshman class of 2002 and the large number of continuing students re-enrolling in the past two years.

Approximately two out of every three transfers who entered UIC in the fall 2004 term last attended an Illinois public two-year institution (895).

2. The top six feeder institutions and the number of transfers to UIC for fall 2004 are:

The top six feeder institutions in 2003 were community colleges; these have been among the top feeders over recent years. UIUC has been the major four-year institution feeder for each of the last thirteen years.

3. The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences has consistently enrolled the largest number of transfer students (up from 556, or 45 percent, in 2003 to 778, 56 percent). The Colleges of Engineering; Business Administration; Architecture and the Arts; Nursing; and Applied Health Sciences each enrolls from 7 to 10 percent of transfer students.
4. More than one-half of the transfers were female (57 percent), and just over half were under 22 years of age (52 percent).
5. Over half of the transfers reported their racial/ethnic category as white (53 percent); 14 percent were Asian/Pacific Islander, 13 percent were Latino/a, and 8 percent were

African American.

6. In 2004, 57 percent of all students transferred as juniors or above, significantly higher than the last two years' rates of 38 percent (fall 2002) and 49 percent (fall 2003). In fall 2003, the campus raised the minimum number of hours required to transfer without reliance on test scores and high school rank to 36 from 24 hours.
7. Nearly four out of five transfer students entered with a mean grade point average of 2.76 or above, and over two of five entered with a mean grade point average of 3.26 and above for previous college work attempted (4.0 scale).

Transfer of credit is vital to the academic careers not only of students admitted as transfers but also UIC native students – previous reports have shown that over sixty percent of the student body transferred credit to UIC. Articulation services are important to most UIC students and the University will continue to support and promote transfer opportunities.

First-Time Undergraduate Transfers From Community Colleges to University of Illinois at Chicago Fall 2004

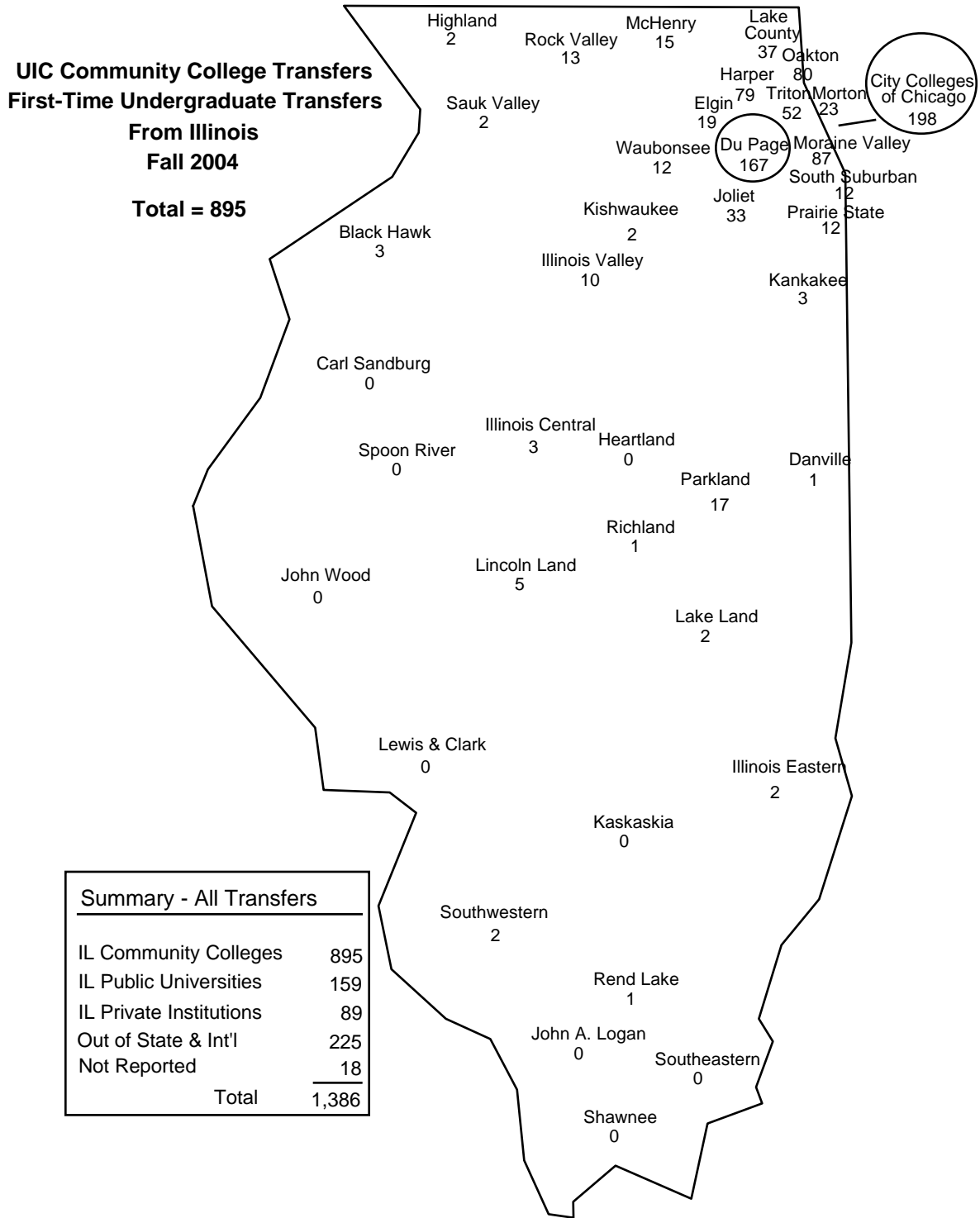
