## UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS CONDENSED ANALYSIS OF THE OPERATING BUDGET FY94-95

The operating budget for the University of Illinois for FY95 is \$1,832,307,000. The budget is comprised of \$778,740,000 received through appropriation by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, and \$1,053,567,000 categorized as institutional and restricted funds which are processed through the University Treasury. The FY95 budget represents an increase from the revised FY94 budget of 3.9 percent; a 5.2 percent increase for State appropriated funds and a 3.0 percent increase for institutional and restricted funds. A summary of the budget by Campus, University Programs, and Central Administration is presented in Schedule A. Further detail by college and departments within each campus is shown in succeeding schedules.

#### **State Appropriations**

State appropriations by the General Assembly for general operations total \$778,740,000. Of this total, \$557,520,300 is from the General Revenue Fund; \$39,240,500 from the Education Assistance Fund; \$15,100,100 from the Agricultural Premium Fund; \$1,529,000 from the Fire Prevention Fund; \$290,000 from the Real Estate Research and Education Fund; and \$165,060,100 from the University Income Fund (primarily tuition). These funds are shown in Schedules A and B and may be allocated by the Board of Trustees for such purposes as the Board approves.

The FY95 budget represents perhaps the most effective combination of additional State tax support, increased student participation, and significant internal reallocation which the University has achieved within recent memory. Although new tax support for the University increased for FY95, the growth was mc:' st, and was below the average increase in total State appropriations. Additional tuition revenues were derived from two sources: a general increase which, net of student assistance contributions, approximated inflation; and a series of special-purpose increases from which all income was specifically dedicated to improvement of instructional programs. The FY95 budget reflects perhaps the most significant redirection of internal resources to critically important priorities that the University has ever accomplished.


Increased tax support provides the basic first component in building an adequate University budget. New State support for the University in FY95 grew by 3.4% (excluding a transfer of funds from the Department of Mental Health) and helped underpin a basic salary increase program averaging 3.5% for all employee groups. Along with the resources from a general tuition increase, additional tax support in the budget approved by the General Assembly and Governor funded the recommendations of the Illinois Board of Higher Education and provided new funds to expand and enhance instructional programs, augment minority scholarship funds, and modestly expand instructional equipment resources. Revenue from special

purpose tuition increases was directed exclusively to instructional program improvements, and has enabled both campuses to add new course sections in areas of greatest student enrollment demand. Additional tuition revenue has also made it possible to begin a program of classroom renovation and technological upgrades long overdue at both campuses.

Approximately \$20.5 million in existing resources were redirected to high priority academic and support programs and to meet unavoidable cost increases in federal Medicare payments for University employees, and to keep pace with the steadily growing obligations under State-mandated sick-leave payments. Additional funds were also reallocated at both campuses to augment funds available for operations and maintenance of new areas.

About half of the total reallocation achieved for FY95 was devoted to salary competitiveness. A large number of other purposes were served by the balance of redirected resources. Among academic program priorities addressed were initiatives such as recruiting and retaining new faculty, especially members of minority groups; continuing implementation of new general education requirements; expanding the availability of graduate fellowships, and enhancing resources available for curriculum development in mathematics and science courses.

One final aspect of the FY95 budget merits mention. Included in the \$38.5 million in new appropriated funds is an increment of \$7.9 million shifted from the Department of Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities to the University for research and education programs in mental health at the University of Illinois at Chicago. This is a significant recognition of both the academic strength of the UIC Department of Psychiatry, and the strong need for the State to seek long term solutions to very serious human service problems. Combined with an increment of \$800,000 which the University received to begin the Great Cities initiative at UIC, the FY95 budget provides a substantial boost to the University's service to the State of Illinois.

#### Institutional and Restricted Funds

Institutional and Restricted funds total \$1,053,567,000. Institutional funds of \$132,472,000 are budgeted from costs recovered on grants and contracts, including balances brought forward from FY94. These funds are budgeted primarily to meet the indirect operating costs associated with the University's sponsored research programs. Restricted and Auxiliary funds total \$924,895,000. These funds are comprised of Federal appropriations of approximately \$22 million; sponsored grants and contracts \$299 million; Medical Service Plan \$58 million; private gifts and grants \$47 million; and sales and services of departments for \$246 million. Auxiliary Enterprises (Housing, Bookstores, Union Buildings, etc.) total \$176 million. Tuition waivers are projected to total \$77 million.

#### Reserve Provisions for Auxiliary Enterprises and Activities

The "University Guidelines 1982", adopted by The Board of Trustees on November 18, 1982, required the University to maintain accounting entities for Auxiliary Enterprises and Activities. Auxiliary Enterprises are operations which are not directly related to instruction, research, or service organizational units but which support the overall objectives of the University. Activities are functions which are self-supporting in whole or in part and are directly related to instructional, research, or service units. Each entity consists of undertakings which are substantially similar and rationally related. In accordance with the "University Guidelines 1982", these entities may maintain capital reserves for equipment replacement and extraordinary maintenance. Reserves are funded from current entity operating funds and conform with criteria as provided in the "University Guidelines 1982".

The extraordinary maintenance reserves of the Auxiliary Facility System and the Willard Airport Project are covered under provisions of their respective bond issues. Maximum reserve provisions are recommended as outlined in Schedule C.

#### **Budget Presentation Change**


The FY95 operating budget reflects the value of student assistance provided through tuition waivers that have not been included in previous budget summaries.

The FY95 budgeted value of student assistance provided through tuition waivers totals approximately \$77 million. This includes approximately \$9 million for undergraduate assistance for tuition waivers mandated by State Statutes and University programs and approximately \$68 million for graduate students. Graduate students employed by the University receive a stipend and a tuition waiver as part of their employment compensation package. Tuition waivers for non-Illinois residents are valued at the out-of-state tuition rates.

#### **GLOSSARY OF TERMS**

#### **EXPENDITURE FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS**

#### **Academic Support**

Expenditures to provide support services for the institution's primary missions—instruction, research, and public service. It includes libraries, museums, educational media services, academic computing support, academic administration, academic personnel development, and course and curriculum development.

#### **Auxiliary Enterprises**

Expenditures for self supporting operations which are not directly related to instruction, research, or public service units but which exist to furnish goods or services to students, faculty, and staff. Examples include food service, residence halls, bookstores, and student unions.

#### Hospital

Expenditures associated with the patient care operations of the hospital. It includes direct patient care, health care supportive services, and administration of the hospital.

#### **Independent Operations**

Expenditures of operations which are independent of, or unrelated to, but which may enhance the primary missions of the institution. It includes commercial operations such as Willard Airport at Urbana-Champaign and the steam plant in Chicago.

#### **Institutional Support**

Expenditures for central executive-level activities concerned with management and long-range planning of the entire institution; fiscal operations including the investment office; administrative data processing; space management; employee personnel and records; logistical activities that provide procurement, storerooms, safety, security, printing, and transportation services to the institution; support services to faculty and staff that are not operated as auxiliary enterprises; and activities concerned with community and alumni relations including development and fund raising.

#### Instruction

Expenditures for all activities that are part of an institution's instruction program. It includes credit and noncredit courses for academic, vocational and technical instruction, and remedial and tutorial instruction.

#### **Operation and Maintenance of Plant**

Expenditures of current operating funds for the operation and maintenance of physical plant. It includes physical plant administration, building maintenance, utilities, and custodial services.

#### **Public Service**

Expenditures for activities that are established primarily to provide noninstructional services beneficial to individuals and groups external to the institution. It includes such services as cooperative extension service, community service, and public broadcasting services.

#### Research

Expenditures for activities specifically organized to produce research outcomes whether commissioned by an agency external to the institution or separately budgeted by an organizational unit within the institution. It includes institutes and research centers and individual and project research.

#### Scholarships and Fellowships

Expenditures for scholarships and fellowships in the form of outright grants to students selected by the institution and financed from current funds, restricted or unrestricted including trainee stipends and awards. (Budget excludes the value of tuition and fee waivers granted staff and graduate assistants.)

#### **Student Services**

Expenditures for offices of admission and registrar and those activities which have the primary purpose of contributing to the student's emotional and physical well-being and to his or her intellectual, cultural, and social development outside the context of the formal instruction program. It includes student services administration, social and cultural development, counseling and career guidance, financial aid administration, and student admissions and records

#### **FUND GROUPS**

#### **State Appropriations**

Expenditures which have a source of funds of state appropriations, including tuition.

#### Non-State Funds

#### Institutional

Expenditures which have a source of funds of institutional costs recovered from grants and contracts, private unrestricted gifts, and educational and administrative allowances.

#### Restricted

Expenditures which have a source of funds of U.S. Government, State of Illinois, and private grants and contracts as well as endowment income, private gifts, work study program, medical service plan, dental service plan, and federal appropriations.

#### **Auxiliary/Departmental Activities**

#### **Auxiliary Enterprises**

Expenditures for self supporting operations which are not directly related to instruction, research, or public service units but which furnish goods or services to students, faculty, and staff. Examples include food service, residence halls, bookstores, and student unions.

#### **Departmental Activities**

Expenditures for operations which are self supporting in whole or part that are directly related to the institution's primary missions -- instruction, research, and service.
