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Analysis of Ten-Year Trends in the Number of Students Transferring to the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign

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Overall, the number of incoming transfer students at University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign has declined over the past ten years. The average number of transfers entering between 1994 and 1998 was 1,140.4, compared to an average of 1,076.8 entering annually between 1999 and 2003. (See Table 1.) This represents a 5.6% decrease. At the same time, the average number of beginning freshmen during these periods was 6,017 and 6,416, respectively. This represents an increase of 6.6%. The University tries to manage enrollments carefully so that the number of students matches available resources.

By Sector

The small decrease in transfer students noted above was largely a result of fewer students coming to the University from other four-year institutions, rather than those coming to the University from two-year institutions. (See Table 1.)

The total number transferring into the University from two-year institutions was fairly consistent over the last 10 years. On average, 701.6 students came to the University from two-year colleges between 1994 and 1998; the average from 1999 through 2003 was 694.4. This is a 1.0% decrease.

The average number of students entering annually from all four-year institutions fell from 395.6 to 315.4, a 20.3% decrease. This decline was spread across institution categories. On average, 161.4 students came to the University from Illinois public universities each year during the 1994 to 1998 period, compared to an annual average of 122.6 during the 1999 to 2003 period, a 24.0% decrease. At the same time, the average number coming from Illinois non-public four-year schools fell from 75.8 to 54.2, a decline of 28.5%. The average from four-year institutions in other states fell from 158.4 to 138.6, a decrease of 12.5%.

By Sending Institution

The numbers of transfer students coming from the majority of sending institutions remained stable over the ten-year period; however, a number of institutions experienced notable changes. The top five sending institutions remained the same in both of the five-year periods covered in this report with Parkland College sending the most transfer students, followed in order by College of DuPage, Illinois Central Community College, Harper College, and University of Illinois at Chicago. These five institutions represent a third of all transfers to UIUC. (See Table 1.)

These data reflect the last institution a student attended and so may not necessarily show the institution from which a student transferred the most coursework. Given its proximity

to UIUC, Parkland may enroll more students who stop in for minimal work before transferring to UIUC than will other institutions, thus somewhat inflating the numbers for Parkland. Nonetheless, transfers from Parkland represent approximately 15% of all transfer students, 167.6 annually on average of the 1,112.0 average total annual transfers between 1994 and 2003. Though the annual average for all institutions dropped by 5.6% from the first five-year period to the second, transfers from Parkland increased by 19.4% on average, increasing from 152.8 to 182.4 students, or an increase of approximately 29 students per year.

On the other hand, three of the four other top feeders show annual average decreases between the two periods: DuPage has decreased by 15.5% (approximately 11 students); Illinois Central has decreased by 11.3% (approximately 5 students); Harper has decreased by 8.4% (approximately 3 students); and UIC has increased by 1.8% (approximately 1 student). Combined, this represents a total of 18 fewer students from these four institutions. Other institutions sent fewer students comparing the first five-year period to the second. Notable are Kishwaukee College with a loss of almost 5 students over the two periods, College of Lake County at over 5 students fewer, and Moraine Valley Community College with almost 6 fewer students on average.

Quite a few Illinois public four-year institutions have demonstrated a trend of sending decreasing numbers of students to UIUC. Notable on this list are Eastern Illinois University (30.4 to 22.4 on average, a 26.3% decline), Illinois State University (28.8 to 15.8 on average, a 45.1% decline), Southern Illinois University at Carbondale (22.2 to 12.0 on average, a 45.9% decline), and Western Illinois University (14.2 to 7.2 on average, a 49.3% decline).

The only four-year institution showing a notable increase over the ten-year period was the University of Illinois at Springfield. Rather than demonstrating a trend, however, this change is a result of a highly unusual number entering in 2003 when 9 students moved from UIS to UIUC, compared to 0 or 1 every other year in the ten-year period. This is likely a result of UIS' adding lower-division students with its Capital Scholars freshmen classes beginning in 2001.

Non-public four-year institutions are not shown by school. Typically, fewer than 10 students come to UIUC annually from any given non-public college or university.

By Receiving UIUC College

Most of the colleges at UIUC have enrolled similar numbers of incoming transfer students over the ten-year period, though with the fluctuations noted below. (See the summary table at the bottom of this section.)

The College of Agriculture, Consumer and Environmental Sciences has been receiving fewer transfer students recently. On average between 1994 and 1998, the college received 110.2 students per year; between 1999 and 2003, the college received an average of 98.2 students per year. This is a 10.9% decline. (See Table 2.)

One of the smaller colleges at the University, the College of Applied Life Studies, enrolls few transfer students each year. The number has increased over the ten-year period, however, moving from an average of 47.6 to an average of 55.8, a 17.2% increase. (See Table 3.)

The Institute of Aviation receives only a handful of transfer students each year, averaging 13.7 annually over the last ten years. The ten-year low occurred in 2001 when only 3 transfer students entered the Institute. The high was in 1994 when 22 students transferred in. (See Table 4.)

The College of Business, in contrast, has increased the number of transfer students enrolled. The average grew by 13.3%, going from 102.4 to 116.0. (See Table 5.)

Each year, the College of Communications receives only about 25 transfer students. The average is up slightly comparing the first half of the ten-year period to the last half. The College received on average 22.4 earlier, and 26.4 later, a 17.9% increase. (See Table 6.)

The College of Education takes few transfer students, and the average has decreased over the last ten years. The average was only 37.0 in the earlier period, and has fallen 25.9% to 27.4. Much of this decrease, however, occurred from 1995 to 1996. As of 1997, students in secondary education enroll in the teaching option in LAS and minor in secondary education, thus, would transfer into LAS and not Education. (See Table 7.)

The trend in the College of Engineering has been to receive fewer transfers. From 1994 to 1998, the college averaged 263.4 new transfers annually; from 1999 to 2003, the college averaged 218.0 transfers each year. This is a 17.2% decline. Considering institutions that on average send 10 or more students to the college, declines can be seen in students coming to UIUC Engineering from College of DuPage, Illinois Central Community College, Parkland College, William Rainey Harper College, and Eastern Illinois University, each of which declined between 20% and 36%. The number coming from all two-year institutions declined from an average of 179.8 to an average of 134.6, (less 20.7%); from Illinois public four-year institutions declined from 43.4 to 30.2 (30.4% lower); and from all Illinois non-public four-year institutions declined from an annual average of 17.8 to an annual average of 11.8 (fewer by 33.7%). (See Table 8.)

The trend in the College of Fine and Applied Arts has been to take slightly fewer transfers over the ten-year period, falling from an annual average of 109.4 to an average of 95.6, a 12.6% decline. The number of students coming from four-year institutions is down from an average of 44.4 to 36.2, an 18.5% decline, and the number coming from two-year institutions declined from 56.8 to 51.2, a 9.9% decrease. (See Table 9.)

As noted, the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the University's largest college, receives the most transfer students. The numbers the college receives has fluctuated over the years from a ten-year high of 530 in 1994 to a ten-year low of 369 in 1999. On average, however, the numbers have remained steady, with 433.6 received on average

between 1994 and 1998 and 429.4 on average between 1999 and 2003, a decline of only 1.0%. The average number transferring to LAS from two-year colleges increased by 9.1%, from 243.6 to 265.8, while the average transferring to LAS from four-year colleges decreased by 14.9%, falling from 173.2 to 147.4. With over 80 students transferring to LAS from Parkland in both 2001 and 2003, the University's major feeder school played a substantial role in offsetting the decline of transfer students from the four-year schools. (See Table 10.)
