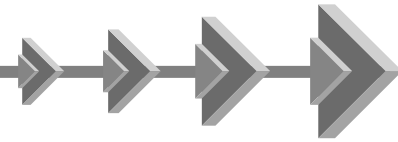


STUDENT COSTS



- ▶ Beginning with the Fall 2004 term, tuition for Illinois resident undergraduate degree-seeking students is guaranteed for a period of at least four consecutive years after a student's initial enrollment in a degree program. The University policy for this statutory program is listed at <https://www.uaps.uillinois.edu/>.
- ▶ Students whose guarantee expires at the end of the four years will be placed in the immediately following cohort for tuition rate purposes, including students who are in differential rate programs for two years. Students who entered 2022-23 will now pay the 2023-24 assessment beginning with the summer 2026 term.
- ▶ Beginning in Fall 2010 all international undergraduate students at Urbana are assessed as a tuition surcharge. There is an additional surcharge for international students in Engineering, Business, Liberal Arts and Sciences, and Information Sciences. These funds are used to offset the increasing costs of international enrollments and for improving the academic programs in the college in which the students enroll.
- ▶ UIUC and UIC have several undergraduate and graduate tuition differentials. New tuition differentials in the last five years are as follows:
 - BS in Information Sciences – 2020-21, UIUC
 - Master of Agriculture and Applied Economics – 2020-21, UIUC
 - MS in Health Administration – 2020-21, UIUC
 - MS in Health Technology – 2020-21, UIUC
 - BS in Kinesiology – 2022-23, UIUC
 - BS in Economics – 2022-23, UIUC
 - Master HRIR – 2023-24, UIUC
- ▶ The universities offer 186 online programs, 79 at UIUC, 23 at UIC and 84 at UIS.
- ▶ Fees provide partial operating support and for debt service payments for various student auxiliary service entities, exclusive of housing. When the mandatory fees for entering students are compared between 2024-25 and 2025-26, the rates increased by 2.6% at UIUC, by 1.5% at UIC, and 4.0% at UIS.
- ▶ Residence hall rates tend to change each year to meet inflationary cost increases in goods and services and to support some measure of program development. Typical double room and board rates for AY 2025 increased by 8% at UIUC, 5% at UIC and 4% at UIS.
- ▶ The campus Offices of Student Financial Aid estimate annual full-time undergraduate costs for attending the University in 2025-26 as

\$36,930 at UIUC for an entering resident student, \$23,490 at UIC for an entering commuter, and \$31,348 at UIS for an entering resident student.
